

RESPONSES TO QUESTIONS REGARDING THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

What age group is served by the young adult treatment court?

This treatment court will serve individuals between the ages of 18 and 25.

What is the young adult treatment court in the 12th Judicial District?

This treatment court, called Restoring Emerging Adults Connections and Hope (R.E.A.C.H.) Court is intended to serve individuals between the ages of 18 and 25 who have been involved in the criminal justice system. The mission of the R.E.A.C.H. court to establish or reestablish connections between participants and the community, with the belief that participants who feel connected to their community are less likely to reoffend or engage in criminal activity. Additionally, addressing not only substance use disorders but trauma and mental health disorders to give hope to young adults who often feel that their life paths have already been determined or that they are unable to change their paths.

Will any modifications to the Draft Contract be negotiated between the parties?

If an Offeror is approved through the RFP process, a contract will be drafted for review and negotiation between the parties

Do the expenditures for this RFP include federal funds?
